TROJAN STUDENT BUILD #3

Monroe High School's Trojan Build 3 is underway. There was some concern over how it would be handled with the COVID-19 restrictions, but Tom Bell and Andy Marchese have the situation under control. There is a limit to how many students can be on-site at a time. but the students are able to use technology to schedule their time on-site. Both instructors also alternate their times on-site and this makes it possible. They also sanitize all tools and equipment daily, helping make it safer. They have made a contingency plan that would allow for this build to span 2 years, but hopefully the system they have in place will keep it at 1 year. It is encouraging to note that there have been students that are graduates of the program and are in the trades as a career path. This is a major endeavor for our association, and one that can pay long term benefits for our industry. We hope to have a fundraiser this fall to provide financial support, but it all depends on the pandemic.
